

Summary: Outdoors for All Summer Camps provide outdoor recreation activities for youth and adults with disabilities. Support staff and counselors with group management and activity delivery; Provide direct support to campers to ensure safety, fun, and learning. Campers will be on the move enjoying activities that may include rock climbing, cycling, hiking, trips to the zoo, and visits to local parks.

Responsible to: Summer Camp staff

When: Monday-Friday June 24th through August 30; 8:30 AM – 3:00 PM. Volunteers must commit to an entire week of camp.

Where: Magnuson Park and Lake Sammamish State Park

Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide a safe, fun, positive, helpful learning experience for Outdoors for All campers.
- 2. Assist campers with activities and support camp staff with activity delivery. Participate in camps activities, which may include hiking, biking, swimming, etc.
- 3. Assist camp staff with group management.
- 4. Engage campers during both activity times and down times (i.e. lunch, van rides)
- 5. Listen and follow staff instructions

Other Expectations:

- 1. Attend and complete all required trainings
- 2. No phone use during camps, unless for emergencies
- 3. Be Punctual.
- 4. Stay with the group.
- 5. Utilize safe and appropriate equipment.
- 6. Adhere to Outdoors for All's policies and procedures, including but not limited to those outlined in the Outdoors for All Volunteer Guidelines and Responsibilities.
- 7. Read all emails and other communications from Outdoors for All staff, and respond if necessary.

Qualifications:

- 1. Ability and desire to work with a wide variety of personalities, skill levels, and abilities.
- 2. Knowledge regarding people with disabilities and recreational activities, recommended.
- 3. Ability to communicate campers' needs and personal needs to staff
- 4. Ability to commit to all responsibilities and expectations.
- 5. Have a positive attitude.
- 6. Ability to stay focused on responsibilities for the duration of camp.
- 7. Be a positive representative of Outdoors for All.
- 8. 14 years or older. Adult Adventure Day volunteers must be 18+.
- 9. Pass a Washington State Background check
- 10. If you are between 14 17 years old, you must fill out an online application, which can be accessed on our website or here.

Outdoors for All staff reserve the right to terminate volunteers when deemed necessary. Failure to follow the expectations and responsibilities listed above may result in consequences such as reassigned job responsibilities and/or dismissal from program depending on severity of infraction
