Mountain Bike Volunteer

Summary: Outdoors for All's Mountain Bike programs offer participants a safe, fun atmosphere to learn and practice safe mountain biking techniques. The focus of some is just to have a safe and fun biking experience while others hope to develop lifelong mountain bike skills. Volunteers can expect to work one-on-one or in small groups with riders that are ages 18+, can independently ride a standard or adaptive mountain bike on varied terrain. Outdoors for All partners with Evergreen Mountain Bike Alliance (EMBA) for mountain bike education. Volunteers will support mountain bike instruction under the Lead Outdoors for All Instructor or EMBA Instructor.

Responsible to: Outdoors for All staff and Evergreen Mountain Bike Alliance Staff (EMBA)

Responsibilities:

- 1. Support mountain bike participant 1:1
- 2. Assist with leading participant on trails as instructed
- 3. Able to facilitate emergency responses as needed
- 4. Provide a safe, fun, positive, helpful learning experience for Outdoors for All participants
- 5. Assist Outdoors for All staff with setup and cleanup of event, which could includes moving bikes
- 6. Responsible for helping to maintain the integrity of the equipment
- 7. Provide basic mountain bike instruction under the guidance of the Lead OFA or EMBA Instructor to participants as needed with support of EMBA volunteers and staff
- 8. Engage participants throughout the activity
- 9. Listen and follow staff instructions

Other Expectations:

- 1. No phone usage, unless for emergencies
- 2. Be Punctual.
- 3. Utilize safe and appropriate equipment.
- 4. Adhere to Outdoors for All's policies and procedures
- 5. Read all emails and other communications from Outdoors for All staff, and respond if necessary

Requirements:

- 1. Able to confidently and competently ride a blue mountain bike trail in the state of Washington
- 2. Must be 18 or older.
- 3. Attend and complete all required trainings (specified online)
- 4. Ability and desire to work with a wide variety of personalities, skill levels, and abilities.
- 5. Ability to commit to all responsibilities and expectations
- 6. Pass a Washington State Background check
- 7. Equipment: personal mountain bike and helmet
